Carnivorous Plants

Heliamphora (South American Pitcher Plant) - Care leaflet

Summer

- > Indirect sun in the summer, humid
- > Rainwater only, it can sit in water, but ensure the plant drinks the water before you refill the saucer. Spray daily, fill up the pitchers
- > Feeding: we have never found this to be necessary, as the plants only require a few insects per year to survive. If you are worried, give it an insect in one of the mature pitchers

Winter

- > This plant prefers temperatures between 10 °C and 25 °C. Grow indoors in winter, full winter sun is fine

Rainwater alternatives: distilled, de-ionised, reverse osmosis water

Repotting: when the plant is bursting out of its pot, in a specific peat and perlite mixture or specialist peat free mix (both available from our on line shop).
